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Your Personal Health

Rowing and its associated training can be a strenuous activity. You should therefore be in good health and have no medical or physical condition precluding heavy exercise. If there is any doubt you should first consult your doctor. Some conditions such as asthma and diabetes, for example, do not prevent individuals participating in the sport, but you do have a **duty to declare any condition that put yourself or others at risk**. Likewise you have a **duty to declare any change** in personal health whilst a member of the Club that may put yourself or others at risk. It is important therefore that you inform those around you e.g. coaches and crew members, of any condition they may have to deal with in the event of an emergency.

Your swimming ability

For your own safety it is important that you are a competent swimmer. As a minimum you must be able to swim 50 metres in light clothing. **If you cannot meet this requirement you cannot row in Grosvenor Rowing Club boats.**
