Open and Women's categories will be split into tiers based on the CRI of the crews and medal awarded to the fastest crew in the tier.
We are aiming to have 'Low CRI' banded events for crews that are new to the sport, provided we have enough entries to make these race groupings viable.

Masters Crews will race in their British Rowing Age categories but where appropriate to ensure fair racing crews will be split by CRI and BR Handicap tables used where necessary.

The draw, event information and regular status updates will be sent by email to the BROE entry secretary for your club.

Club Entries Secretaries please ensure the "Competition Contact" for each crew (Name and Mobile Phone Number) is populated on BROE. This person should be at the event on the day, they should not be in the crew, we will make contact with them if the crew needs urgent support on the day eg if there is a capsized or medical emergency.

Crews in under-subscribed events will be moved to the next available status in order to provide competition. Please make a comment on the entry in BROE if you want to be contacted before crews are moved.

Prizes: Class winners will receive medals
(two crews must race for a win to be declared).
